### #150 Transposed Teachings

Hi Rabbi,

If Christianity came from Judaism, does that make every Christian a Jew, technically?

Thanks. Giana Souse Dear G. Souse.

You're a musician, so picture this. In the 1840s, Adolphe Sax wanted to perfect woodwind instruments. As a clarinet player, he thought he could make a similar instrument that was easier to use, had sound, and had consistent

fingering. So he created saxophone. saxophones are therefore

clarinets, right?

No, I didn't think so. Right now, every musician is nodding his or her head, and people who aren't musicians are like, "huh?"

Let's examine two important reasons why Christians aren't automatically Jews:


In order to be a Jew you have to

either be born into it, or have a formal conversion. The earliest Christians were born Jews, so they remained Jews, as far as we're concerned. But that all changed a really, really long time ago. Once the Roman empire became Christian, most people practicing that religion were not from Jewish blood. Sure, someone born a Christian can convert to Judaism, but there is a detailed process for that to happen, and it is certainly not automatic.


The actual Christian religion is drastically different from Judaism. Sure, it started as a form of Judaism, and on the surface there are still some similarities, but at the core of these two faiths, they are as different as fire and teddy bears. ## Stump the Rabb;

between Christianity and Judaism:

We celebrate our Sabbath on Saturday, they use Sunday

We believe the original 5 books of the Torah are divine and eternal. Meaning we still keep the rules of what the Christians call the 'Old Testament? This includes Kosher, Shabbat, circumcision, the holidays, tefillin, etc."

We don't pray to people, or pretend they have any divine power. Many of the largest Christian groups believe in their leader as godly, and most pray to him.

A fundamental concept in Christianity is that the Messiah has already come. We reject that thought, because clearly we DON'T live in an age of peace and perfection.

All Christians believe that Jesus was the Messiah and also a prophet. He can't be the Messiah because he's not patrilineally descended from King David. The Torah explicitly disqualifies any prophecy that argues with its basic rules, as Christisnity does.

The list goes on, but back to our discussion.

Christianity definitely has its roots in Judaism, but it's a completely different religion now. Therefore, someone born to two Christian parents would definitely NOT be automatically a Jew. As I mentioned, though we don't seek or encourage conversions, that door is open as long as it's done properly.
